



## Town of Orange, Connecticut

Effective July 1, 2020

1. All landscapers, building contractors, landlords and commercial businesses that want to use the Orange Transfer Station, must obtain a 2020 Permit. Vehicles registered in Orange, \$40.00. Vehicles registered out of town, \$50.00. The 2020 stickers must be on the front driver's bumper of the vehicles or they will not be allowed to use the Transfer Station. **A valid vehicle registration must be submitted for each sticker issued. All debris must be from Orange.**
2. All vehicles will be weighed in and out of the Transfer Station. The fee will be pro-rated at the price per pound times the actual weight of acceptable waste. MSW will be charged at the rate of \$.049 per lbs. prorated and Bulky Waste will be charged at the rate of \$.15 per lbs. prorated. Brush is \$.0375 per lbs. prorated. Contaminated leaves must be deposited in the brush pile and will be charged as brush. **We do not accept grass clippings.**  
  
*\* As of 2017 There is a fee for leaves \$25 per Pickup & \$45 for Mason Dump load*
3. All outstanding balances must be paid or a new permit will not be issued. A list of customers with outstanding balances will be posted at the Orange Transfer Station, and **delinquent accounts will not be allowed access to the facility.**
4. All refuse brought in a vehicle with a commercial sticker will be charged the commercial rate.
5. A homeowner or property owner, accompanying a contractor to the Disposal Area **does not waive the disposal fee.**
6. All material must be separated and disposed of in the proper designated area. Wood, brush, and metal must be cut in 4ft. lengths or smaller. Painted and contaminated (treated) wood should be put in the Bulky Waste pile. Logs over 4 inches in diameter go in the log pile. All other wood and brush under 4" in diameter should go in the brush pile. Pallets in the Bulky Waste pile.
7. Anyone found violating the rules and regulations outlined herein, will have their permit revoked, and/or charges will be imposed to cover the cost of any expense incurred from the violation.
8. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT COMMERCIAL CARDBOARD**
9. All commercial vehicles must give their company name, sticker number & **resident address where work is being done** to scale attendant before they proceed to any disposal area.

The Public Works Department's Office hours are from 8:30-4:30, Monday through Friday.
