Reports

Activity for January: Assistant Chief Martins discussed January statistics with the Commissioners. The Board was informed that in January there were 49 criminal arrests and 68 motor vehicle citations. There were no burglaries, no stolen motor vehicles and 1 recovered motor vehicle. In addition, there were 37 larcenies and 65 motor vehicle accidents. There were 3,043 calls for service that generated 462 written reports.

Assistant Chief Martins reported that the Records Division took in report sales of \$95.00, \$530.00 in permits, \$15.00 in fingerprints, and \$300.00 in parking tags for a total of \$940.00 in January.
