Minutes

Commissioner Cuzzocreo seconded by Commissioner Barton, made the motion to approve the minutes of the June 12, 2023 Traffic Authority Meeting. **The motion passed 3-0 with Commissioners Carveth and Walker abstaining.**

Old Business

Firelite Plaza: Chief Gagne advised the Board that the State is approving the administrative decision for this project. There will be minor changes, that Chief Gagne has not yet been made aware of. He did discuss the cross-walk situation at the state intersection and the State agrees they have concerns and are treating the issue separate from the application.

New Business

Derby Milford Road Radar Sign: Chief Gagne advised that the State funded two solar powered speeds signs for our use to supplement the speed trailer. Lt. LaPlante, who handles our traffic issues, suggested the one permanent one be placed on Derby Milford Road, between Rail Fence and East Slope. This area is a high speed and accident area. Commissioner Carveth, seconded by Commissioner Walker made a motion to support this recommendation and place the sign on Derby Milford Road. **The motion passed unanimously.** Discussion ensued regarding the second sign and Chief Gagne advised that we are considering an initial placement on Mapledale Road near Orange Center Road.
