Old Business

235 Boston Post Road, presented by Jeff Gordon, Codespoti & Associates. Mr. Gordon presented a revised plan that shows a change to the parking area per the request of the Fire Marshal for truck access. He also reviewed level of service changes in peak travel times. Discussion ensued regarding entrances and exits, in regards to Boston Post Road and Webster Bank.

Commissioner Cuzzocreo, seconded by Commissioner Carveth made a motion to approve the plan as presented. The motion passed 3-1 with Commissioner Walker abstaining.

Firelite Commons: Chief Gagne made the Board aware of the recent fatal accident that occurred on Old Tavern Road. He explained that we have placed the speed trailer in that area and have spoken with Michael Ott, the architect for the Firelite Commons project and requested that they add the agreed upon crosswalk sooner. Mr. Ott confirmed with the developer and they will proceed with that cross walk and are meeting to discuss the exact location with possibly adding rapid flashing beacons. A letter has been sent to the state requesting a cross walk at the Boston Post Road/Racebrook Road intersection.
