The meeting was called to order by Dennis Marsh, at 10:01 a.m. in the Lower-Level Meeting Room of the Town Hall.

The meeting minutes of March 16, 2022 were tabled due to lack of a quorum.

Old Business:

a. Sign for Senior Lounge Door: Dennis will follow up with John Stewart to see if he ordered one.

b. Town Hall Tree: Don Foyer will be putting the Norway Maple in the back of Town Hall on a future tree list for removal.

New Business:

- a. Flu and Covid Clinics: Terry Waldron was not able to attend because she was at the Senior Flu clinic at HPCC. She sent a report that Ann Denny read into the record. The OVNA is still caring for Covid patients using covid precautions. Staff continue to mask with every patient. N95 mask and full isolation gear if patient is positive. There is a Health and Safety fair Friday 9/23 at HPCC from 9-1. Flu clinics will be weekly at HPCC in the probate court room, every Wednesday thru October 11-1. No appointment is necessary and there are also numerous Covid clinics scheduled. The OVNA continues with flu and Covid vaccinations to the homebound by appointment only.
- b. Community Center Safety & Security: There are 3 tiles missing at HPCC by the sliding door and Dennis stated it is a tripping hazard. He has asked John and Rickie to fill it in and make sure it is safe. Dennis would like to see the Senior Lounge door locked he feels this is a safety hazard. Ann will advise the First Selectman regarding locking the door.

There was no other new business on a motion made by Dennis Marsh, seconded by Don Foyer and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned at 10:11 a.m. The next meeting is December 14, 2022.
