**Review of Latest Financial Report:** Reviewed and discussed reimbursables accounts. Went over 2025-2026 Budget Narrative.

#### **Director's Report:**

- State Grant will be awarded to Senior Center; Stacey and Dennis are working on what these funds will be used for.
- Grace has been hosting Holiday Traditions, an intergenerational program where they have made holiday cards and blankets.
- Discussed potentially moving the newsletter to exclusively online for out of town residents in the future due to postage increases.
- \$12,895 in cash donations have been made so far to the Food and Fuel Bank.
- 2 households have used the fuel bank this year.
- Motion made to increase Senior Center membership fee for out-of-town residents to \$25 for an individual and \$35 for two people living in the same household effective as early as operationally possible. Accepted (Hadlock/Miller)

- Veteran's Day Cabaret was held November 11<sup>th</sup> and was well attended.
- Classes: Fitness, Yoga and Zumba continue to be successful; Drumming for Seniors has been well attended.
- Movie of the Month – “Dream Horse”, “Red One” and “Home Alone”
- Art Classes including “Painting for Pleasure” and “One and Done Drawing” continue.
- New Crocheting and Knitting Group began to meet bimonthly.
- Pasta Making Classes will be held again in January.
- Line Dancing Class has been back and is being well received.
- Lion's Club Thanksgiving Dinner was successfully held on November 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Book Club read “West with Giraffes” and was well attended.

#### **Transportation Report:**

- The Center is now transporting on average, 8-9 people a day to the Senior Center to participate in activities.
- 384 rides were given in October to Orange residents.
