

ORANGE TOWN POOL Lifeguard Job Description

Age: Minimum 15 years of age

CERTIFICATION:

Required: (1) Current American Red Cross Lifeguard Training

The primary responsibility of the lifeguard is to directly supervise patrons in an effort to prevent accidents, both in the water and on the immediate deck area. The secondary responsibility is to respond to emergencies by performing rescues and providing appropriate on-scene care, including water rescue, removal and first aid.

Other responsibilities include but are not limited to:

1. Attendance and money tabulation
2. Janitorial duties including moping, deck hosing, etc.
3. Maintaining general cleanliness
4. Maintaining a neat and safe aquatic environment
 - a. Conduct daily safety checks of the facility and equipment
5. Maintaining current Red Cross certifications
6. Attendance at any staff meetings
7. Meeting minimum physical fitness standards including:
 - a. Reporting for duty in a fit condition
 - b. All Lifeguard water rescue skills
 - c. 300-yard continuous swim
 - d. Ability to perform all first aid duties; including CPR, rescue breathing, and wound management
8. Abide by all Parks & Recreation Rules and Regulations, including staffing guidelines published in the operations manual
9. Ability to remain alert, focused, and professional during long periods of surveillance
10. Complete familiarity with the emergency plans and procedures
 - a. Recognize and respond quickly and effectively to all emergencies
 - b. Administer first aid, CPR, and AED use when necessary
